SALZBURG WEILL CORNELL SEMINARS
OF THE OPEN MEDICAL INSTITUTE (OMI)



NEW FRONTIERS

In 1993, Central and Eastern Europe, Central Asia and the former Soviet Union were a new frontier. After the fall of the Iron Curtain, young physicians, eager for access to Western medicine were leaving their countries. To stem the brain drain Weill Cornell Medicine, the AAF and OSF (Open Society Foundation) launched the Salzburg Cornell Seminars. From 1993 to 2023 more than 27,000 physicians from 130 countries have attended seminars taught by more than 2,500 faculty members, all of whom serve pro bono, donating more than 5500 weeks of their time.

In 2010, Pablo and Almudena Legorreta founded Alianza Médica para la Salud (AMSA) establishing a hub in Mexico facilitating the participation of physicians from Mexico, Central, Latin and South America. To date 742 physicians have participated in OMI seminars.

In July 2023, OMI established a third hub in Vietnam with VinUniversity, a private, not-for-profit university established in 2019 by the Vingroup, the largest private conglomerate in Vietnam. VinUniversity collaborates with Cornell University and the University of Pennsylvania, who are also OMI's academic partners. Two OM seminars took place with fellows from Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia attending.

The work of the Open Medical Institute is essential to building healthcare workforce capacity and preventing brain drain of physicians from low income countries. Quality healthcare is vital for sustainable development and to guarantee access to quality healthcare, there must be qualified physicians in all parts of the world.

Today OMI's network spans the globe. OMI's multiple fellowship opportunities and life-long mentoring have significantly improved healthcare delivery worldwide by educating physicians who are committed to staying in their countries, sharing their knowledge with colleagues and working for the benefit of all their patients.
